The Hurricane season of 2005 taught us many valuable lessons of safety and preparedness. It was both of these aspects that enabled State Investors to have a branch open and operating just days after the storm, a task not easily accomplished.

To help us and you in future situations such as this, we have compiled some helpful hints for you to use.

Design an evacuation plan - Plan ahead, compile a route and start looking for hotels in that area. Make a list of these hotels so that when the need arises you are prepared.

Emergency Contact list - Make a list of family, friends, credit card companies (with account numbers) mortgage company, insurance company and doctors.

Important Documents -Make sure you bring all pertinent and important documents with you, including, driver's license / ID, checks, deposit slips, passbooks, Insurance papers, tax papers and at least one utility or credit card bill showing proof of residence.

Prescription Bottles - Bring actual bottles of the prescriptions that have been prescribed to you, this will help ease the refill process should you evacuate.

Take Photos Before You Leave - Take photos of the contents of each room of your home / business before you leave.

Text Messaging Service - Check with your cellular phone service provider on what type of text messaging programs are available to you. When cell towers are down, text messaging is still available. This service is invaluable when trying to contact loved ones following a storm
